This listing was compiled by William Coles and Stanley Griffith, and was research conducted by them in the writing of *The Postal Markings of New Jersey Stampless Covers*, which was published in 1983 by the Collectors' Club of Chicago. The period covered is from the beginning of Statehood (1789) and the end of stampless covers (1857) – as this was the area of research for the original book.

INTRODUCTION

The following listings were secured as a by-product of the researching for information for "The Postal Markings of New Jersey Stampless Covers" published in 1983.

Unless otherwise stated "date established" was obtained from the six volumes of "Records of Appointment of Postmasters 1789-1856" at the Post Office Department Archives. These consist of the dated appointments of the first postmaster for each town, and the date of appointment of each succeeding postmaster. Where no date of appointment was shown, then the date of the first recorded quarterly report to the Postmaster General was used.

This data was supplied by the Post Office Department as a microfilm copy of the original records. Where the original book had been repaired, it was frequently quite difficult to accurately interpret the entry. Hence, there may be some mistakes. It could also be seen that some entries were spelled phonetically.

It will be noted that prior to 1832 many postmasters served for several years. After the election of Andrew Jackson in 1829, the spoils system of selection of postmasters according to their political beliefs caused many of their terms to be of short duration and from then on frequently being out of office for four years and then reappointed.

Many of the post offices listed show their names were "changed to" or "changed from". There are several reasons why this happened. When a political party changed as a result of a national election, many of the postmasters were changed as previously mentioned. The new postmaster might have had a store in a nearby town, so the post office was moved to that town. One example is Sooy Inn changed to Green Bank and later to Atsion. In some instances the inhabitants wanted the name of the town changed. An example is Evesham changed to Marlton. This was not political as the town had been known locally as Marlton for some years. When the Morris Canal was constructed, the post office was changed from Anderson to Port Colden. Then in five years time it reverted to Anderson.

Abbreviations of Counties following the town name indicate the county as of 1857. Those in brackets are the previous county name before the change. Names of previous post offices or early town names are listed in some cases when it was thought to be helpfull.

The basic Bibliography used for this article is the same as listed in the manuscript group shown in "The Postal Markings of New Jersey Stampless Covers". "New Jersey Postal History" by John L. Kay & Chester M. Smith Jr. was referred to constantly to check all of the dates and names of postmasters shown herein.

This completes the printing of Bill Coles' typescript and provides a point of departure for others to assemble information about the following postmasters.

At the NOJEX awards banquet on May 29, 1988, Bill was presented with a medal marking fifty years of membership in the American Philatelic Society. Bill Welch, editor of The American Philatelist, remarked upon Bill's contributions to the hobby over a very long time. In addition to contributions to NJPH and the AP, Bill has authored articles for the Classics Society's Chronicle and the Postal History Journal. And of course, one must not forget his momentous book on the preadhesive markings used in New Jersey.

NOJEX saw other awards as well. Craig Mathewson received a vermeil medal for his exhibit of Cape May covers. Fred MacDonald took a silver with a display of the railroad post office markings of New Jersey. The Grand Award went to George Kramer for a stupendous exhibit of the telegraph company adhesives of the United States..

Attendance was high and the Society's table seemed to be well patronized.
